

Chief Minister of Madhya Pradesh inaugurates CRISP's Centre

Honorable Chief Minister, **Shri Shivraj Singh Chauhanji** inaugurated *Livelihood and Skill Development Center at Budhni (Dist Sehore)* on the 9th of July, 10. A prestigious project of Department of Panchayat and Rural Development, Govt. of Madhya Pradesh in establishing *Centres through CRISP at the Block level of 5 district's namely Dhar, Khargone, Tikamgarh, Sagar & Sehore. These Centre will provide computer based employment-oriented Training programs to the local youth and assistance for employment & business.*

The Chief Minister appreciated this joint challenging initiative of the Department and CRISP and said that this effort in developing the skills of the rural youth in market demanded trades and take – up employment in these areas, is a step towards realizing the dreams of the rural youth belonging to the BPL families to earn a decent livelihood and raise their living standards through employment.

On this occasion Cabinet Minister for Panchayat & Rural Development **Shri Gopal Bhargavaji** , Principal Secretary **Shri R. Parshuramji** and CEO of CRISP **Mr. Mukesh Sharma** were also present. About 40 students are attending first batch of the training.

Training in other trades / sectors will also be taken-up in these centres, depending on demand and job requirement – as electrician, engineering trades, Sales & marketing, ready-made garments, security services, handicrafts, etc.
